

Henry finally has win in Bill Kile 4-miler

In his fifth try, Tim Henry of Voorhees clocked a winning time of 23:39.

PENNSAUKEN—The fifth time turned out to be the charm for Tim Henry, a 20-year-old runner from Voorhees, in the 11th annual Bill Kile's Memorial Run here last Saturday.

Competing in the four-mile race for the fourth time in the last five years, Henry was victorious after placing fifth overall in his last three appearances.

Deptford's Marc Cianfrani, who had won the event the previous four years, did not compete last weekend.

Henry led the field of 87 finishers on the hot and humid morning with a winning time of 23:39 on the TAC-certified loop course at Cooper River Park.

Henry's other showings in the annual memorial run were as follows: 2001 (18th; 26:41), 2003 (5th; 23:41), 2004 (5th; 22:52) and 2005 (5th; 24:35). In each year, Henry earned age-group champion honors.

Other top finishers were Tommie Mulligan, 39, Haddon Township (23:55); John Yanzuk, 37, Clayton (24:50); Reinaldo Reyes, 48, Maple Shade (25:58) and Jim Stein, 50, Yardley, Pa. (26:13) in second through fifth place, respectively.

Antoinette Snyder, 34, of Pennsauken successfully defended her crown in the women's division.

Snyder led the way for the field of 30 female participants with her 19th-place time of 28:15.

Taylor Ecker, 10, of Marlton won the one-mile fun run with a time of 8:19.

Proceeds from the event benefit The William H. Kile, Jr. Humanitarian Scholarship Fund at Pennsauken High School.

This year's recipients were Royce Harris and Chynae' Walker, who were both on hand last Saturday to assist with the presentation of the awards to the runners.

In 10 years, the memorial run has raised \$15,700 for the scholarship fund and approximately \$1,000 was earned from this year's event.

Pennsauken was the last place of employment for Kile, who worked there for three years as the head of the English and Foreign Languages Department before retiring.

Kile was best known for more than 30 years of service in the state Department of Education. He first taught in the Berlin Township School District in the 1960s.

A native of Marlton, Kile died Sept. 11, 1996 at the age of 61 after a lengthy battle with melanoma (skin cancer.) He was an avid runner who completed in nine marathons.
